2024 FRANK LOWY FELLOWSHIP AWARDED

Scentre Group's Head of Parking and Valet, Derek Cable, has been announced as the 2024 recipient of the Shopping Centre Council of Australia's (SCCA) 2024 Frank Lowy Fellowship.
